
## SYMPOSIUM PUBLICATIONS

The final publication of the project Terra Incognita, *TERRA EUROPA*. *EARTHEN ARCHITECTURE IN THE EUROPEAN UNION* is a book of 220 illustrated pages which gives an overview of earthen architecture, traditional and contemporary, in Europe. First publication of this type, it contains contributions from almost 27 authors of the European

Union and proposes an atlas of earthen architecture on this territory scale (English version only).



**TERRE EN VUES**, is the catalogue of the exhibition of the Belgian photographer Peter Buch which will be presented in Marseille on 4 and 5 May 2011. This catalogue contains 60 photographs of traditional and contemporary architecture realized in the four partner countries of the European project Terra Incognita (France, Italy, Spain and Portugal), from June till September, 2010. Pierre Buch delivers here his glance, that of a man sensitive to material, forms and

graphic lines of earthen architecture.
